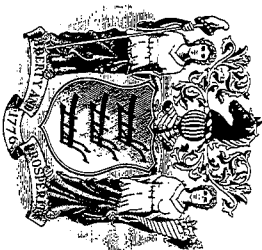

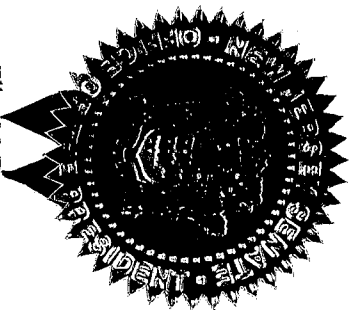
WHEREAS, In construction since December of 2007, the Wind-To-Energy Project will consist of the installation of

Be It Resolved by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

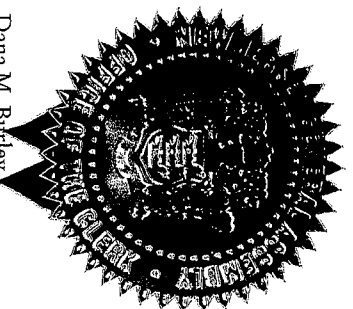




