The Bayshore Regional Sewerage Authority (Authority) has an immediate need for an experienced and reliable Journeyman Electrician to install, repair, and maintain a variety of electrical systems, including electrical panels, lighting, motor controls, and conveyor systems. Our ideal candidate has at least five years of journey worker level experience, three (3) of which must include performing the maintenance, repair, and overhaul of large electrical equipment, transformers, motor control centers, distribution systems, and other electrical devices similar to those used in wastewater treatment facilities, a current New Jersey Electrical Contractor's License, and should be familiar with installing power supply wiring, troubleshooting industrial types of electrical components, and performing a variety of skilled technical duties and semi-skilled labor in the maintenance of the Authority's wastewater treatment plant, remote metering chambers, and pump stations.

The Authority is a major regional wastewater treatment facility with offices located in Union Beach, Monmouth County, NJ. The Authority provides wastewater service to a population of approximately 100,000 residents encompassing the municipalities of Hazlet, Holmdel, Union Beach, Aberdeen, Matawan, Keyport, Keansburg and a portion of Marlboro.

The duties and responsibilities of the position include, but not limited to, inspection and maintenance of the Authority's pumps, motors, industrial equipment etc. Produce proper legible logs, records, and forms. Maintain proper communication with and reports all equipment malfunctions and operational irregularities. Perform necessary housekeeping duties required to maintain a safe, healthy, and regulatory compliant work environment indoors and outdoors. Work experience that demonstrates basic knowledge of electronic control devices, such as variable frequency drives. Adhere to all safety standards and exhibits the ability to take corrective measures should a safety hazard occur. Comply with all BRSA rules, regulations, safety policies, and procedures This is a full-time position, Monday through Friday.

Qualified candidates should possess a minimum of High School Diploma or GED.
